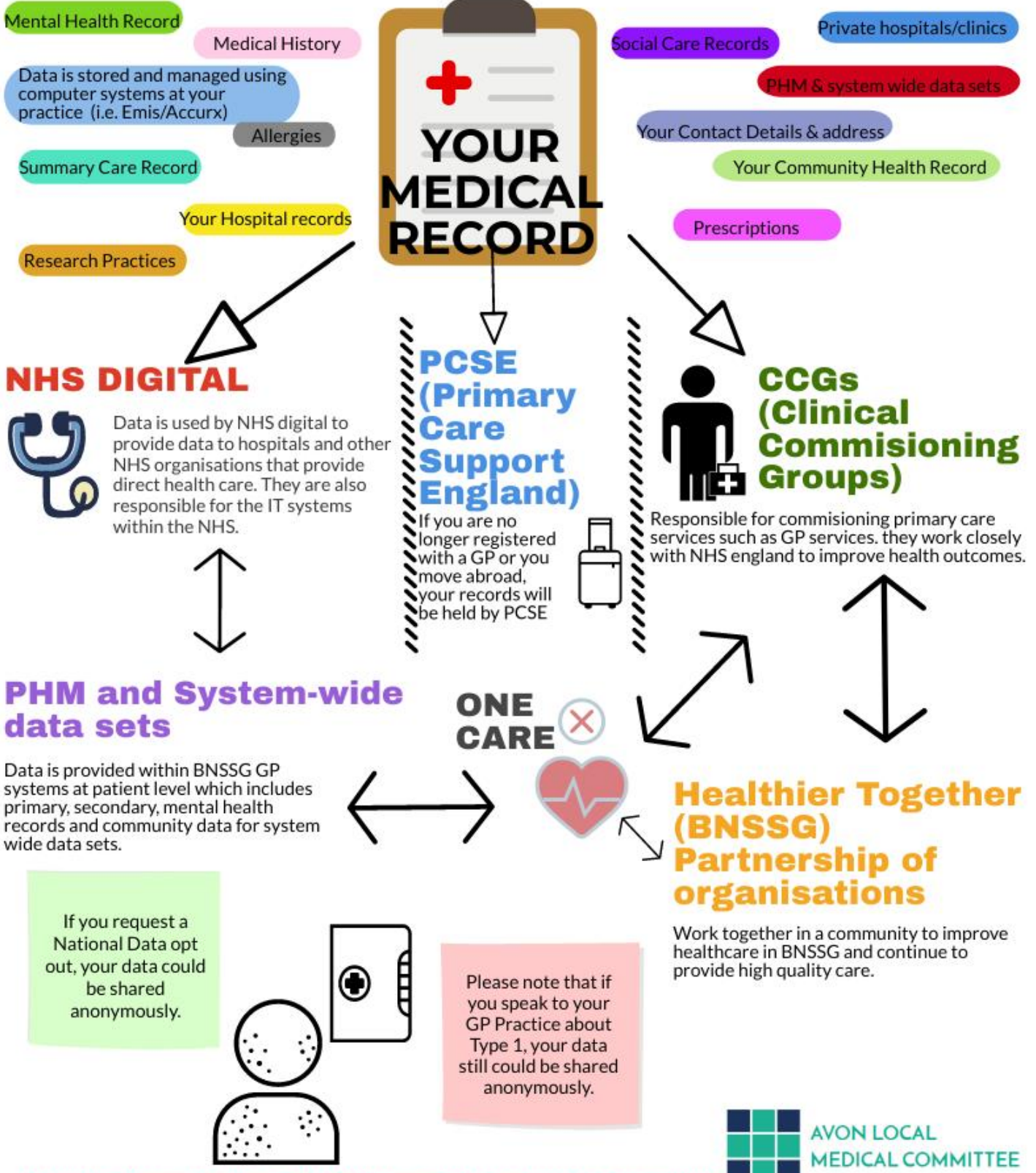


My Medical Record: Where Could My Data Go?

National Data Opt Out & Type 1 Opt Out



National Data Opt Out

You can contact NHS Digital on [0300 303 5678](tel:03003035678) or visit their website (<https://digital.nhs.uk/about-nhs-digital/contact-us>) for this.

If you choose this option, it means that your medical record is **ONLY** shared with NHS Digital.

OPT OUT TYPE 1:

You can contact your GP Practice for this.

If you choose this option it means your identifiable data is blocked from access from other organisations outside your GP practice.

Data Opt Out and Type 1 will **NOT** apply if it is a legal requirement (Article 6. GDPR) such as:

- Legal Obligation
- Public Interest
- Consent
